Education majors will receive higher consideration. Applicant must be a high school student in Howell or Ozark County.

In order to apply, please complete the application attached, and include:

1. Copy of high school transcript
2. **Essay OR Audition tape/CD/DVD** – If an essay, must be 500 words or less on one of the following topics:
 - a. Will traditional art and/or music survive in the modern world? Why?
 - b. Who or what inspires you?
 - c. Should art and music receive equal consideration in secondary education?
 - d. How I support the arts.
3. You may include a résumé detailing extracurricular activities, volunteer activities, community service, and jobs held during the past four years.
